

## Trees In The Parish Of Rope

**Each year, Rope Parish Council appoints a specific Councillor as 'The Tree Warden'.**

Residents of Rope are so lucky to have such wonderful mature trees in the parish but it is important to be aware of the work that goes on to retain and enhance this situation.

Over the last few years, work has been carried out by The Tree Warden working alongside the Landscape Trust to acquire new trees for planting in the open spaces in our parish such as Berkeley School Grounds, and Oak Tree Walk as well as

the natural open spaces elsewhere.

In addition, an extensive survey was carried out in 2008 with Cheshire East to identify significant or prominent trees in the area in order to apply Tree Preservation Orders on them.

This work may not have captured all the trees in the area and if you know of any that you think should be protected, please do not hesitate to inform the Clerk so that The Tree Warden can continue to protect our trees.
