

Rope Parish Footpaths

Footpath Rope FP4:

The footpath from Eastern Road is across arable land however there is not a defined path through the crops.

At the steps at the road farm ramp which leads to the bridge over the A500 the footpath sign is lying flat on the ground. There is a stile here however I would recommend a kissing gate which would help both those less mobile and particularly helpful for dog walkers.

Footpath Willaston FP13

The footpath begins to the right of the railway bridge in Rope Lane, it cuts to the right in a cul de sac prior to the lights.

First Stile here, there is a space to the right adequate in width for most to not have to use the stile. Would make sense to have a poo bin just inside the field by this stile.

The path follows diagonally to the right to an open gate that is broken, to the right of which are two stiles in and out of ground to the right of the gate.

Continuing diagonally through the next field with an open pond (unprotected) to the right, the path proceeds to a gated fence (no stile), gate was tied (presumably by the landowner), no access.

Following the line of the fence to the left there is an opportunity to enter the next field where two stiles can be found, which are in good order, however to access this field deviation is needed from the route.

Oaktree Walk

There's a tree overhanging the path and when it has been raining or windy its nigh on impossible to walk without either ducking under or walking around on the muddy grass.
