Rope Parish Footpaths

Footpath Rope FP4

The footpath from Eastern Road is across arable land however there is not a defined path through the crops.

At the steps at the road farm ramp which leads to the bridge over the A500. There is a stile here however I would recommend a kissing gate which would help both those less mobile and particularly helpful for dog walkers.

Footpath Willaston FP13

The footpath begins to the right of the railway bridge in Rope Lane, it cuts to the right in a cul de sac prior to the lights. The first stile is here and the gap to the right has now been filled in by the land owners which means the path is now difficult or nigh on impossible for dog walkers. A kissing gate would help those less mobile and dog walkers. The following stile at the end of the first field has also had gaps filled in by the landowner again making it difficult for dog walkers. A kissing gate here would also help those less mobile and dog walkers. Once in the second field continuing diagonally through the next field with an open pond (unprotected) to the right, the path proceeds to a gated fence and ladder stile again difficult for those less mobile.

The rest of the way is straightforward with clear way markers. There is a new bridge and stile over the small brook approaching the Willaston end of the walk.
